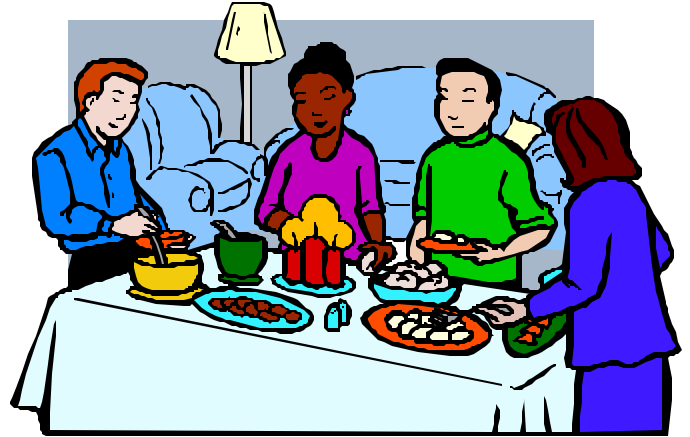
# EGG HUNT & COVERED DISH

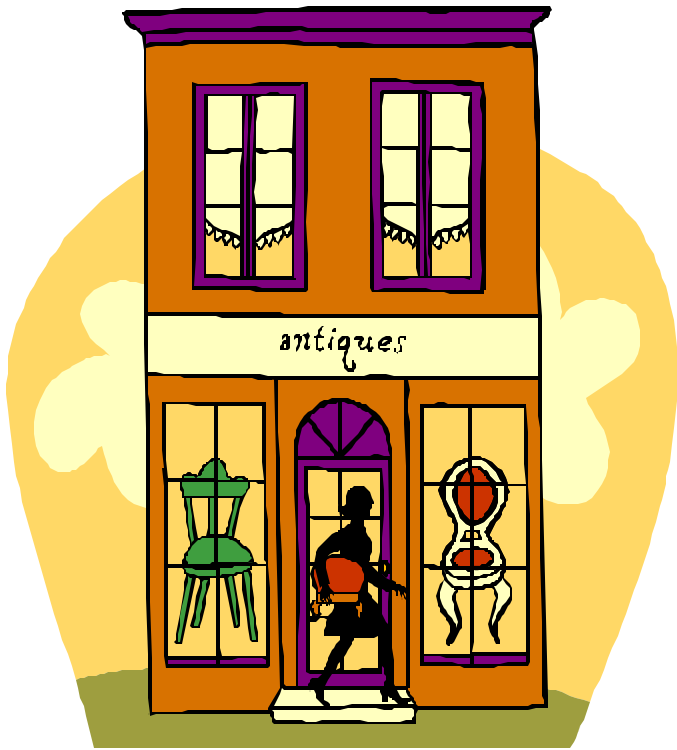
## LUNCH AND STILL POND
